The New Jersey State Data Center working in cooperation with the Regional Offices of the US Census Bureau is offering half day workshops (approximately 3 hours) for county and municipal staff and clerks on Using Census Data with Tiger Line Shape-files to create thematic maps with ArcGIS software. The primary focus of the workshop will be hands-on computer training with ArcGIS, Tiger Line products and downloadable shape-files from American FactFinder. Additional resources to create thematic maps with Census data will be demonstrated. Attendees should have some familiarity with GIS software.
