III. New 2021 Edition! Salary Report of Municipal Positions Available Now

The latest edition of the New Jersey Municipal Salary Report is now available, including salaries for over 40 municipal positions. This is a digital report that includes self-reported data for 192 municipalities in a Microsoft Excel Spreadsheet, as well as statewide comparisons based on the responses received. The data was gathered from a recent survey conducted by the League, and includes salary data for 2021 and 2020.
