*William G. Dressel, Jr.*

UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE NEW JERSEY LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES

*WHEREAS, on Tuesday, June 30, 2015, Executive Director William G. Dressel, Jr. will retire from the New Jersey League of Municipalities after 41 years of executive service; and*

*WHEREAS, Mr. Dressel earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science and Social Science from Elon College in North Carolina. He also holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration from West Virginia University; and*

*WHEREAS, Mr. Dressel joined the League's staff in 1974, just as the New Jersey Legislature was beginning to open the Committee hearing process to facilitate public comment. He quickly established a local government presence in the State House. Generations of New Jersey local elected officials have relied on his service as their eyes, ears and voice in Trenton. On July 1, 1995, he assumed the duties of Executive Director; managing a broad spectrum of programs and services for the NJSL of Municipalities, which represents all of the State's 565 municipalities and a membership of over 13,000 elected and appointed municipal officials; and*

*WHEREAS, Mr. Dressel has received many accolades over the course of his career including; the Sarah P. Fiske Award by Preservation New Jersey, Inc. for efforts in preserving the Ferdinand W. Roebing Sr. Mansion in Trenton and the John G. Stutz Award recognizing more than 25 years of League service; and*

*WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Office of the Mayor and the City of Camden honor those individuals and organizations who have contributed to the enrichment of their community through their service and projects;*
