### **Mayor Sue Howard Elected NJLM 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President**

**Trenton, NJ** – Mayor Sue Howard of Monmouth Beach is the new 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President of the New Jersey State League of Municipalities. Mayor Howard was elected at the League of Municipalities' Annual Business Meeting in Atlantic City.

As 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President of the New Jersey State League of Municipalities, Mayor Howard will help lead the Association of New Jersey's 565 municipal governments. She will represent the interests and needs of New Jersey's local elected officials to county, state, and federal governments.

Susan Howard is currently serving her fourth term as Mayor of Monmouth Beach. Mayor Howard began her public service in 1996 when she was elected to the Monmouth Beach Board of Education serving for nine years, six as President. She also served one year on the Shore Regional High School Board of Education. She is a member of the New Jersey League of Municipalities Executive Board and serves on the Legislative Committee. She is also Co-Chair of League's Women in Municipal Government Committee. She is a member of the New Jersey Conference of Mayors Board of Directors and Co-Chairs the Legislative Committee. Mayor Howard is a strong advocate for shore protection serving on the Executive Board and is President of the Jersey Shore Partnership.

Mayor Howard began her 39-year career in telecommunications at Bell Laboratories and went on to work at Southwestern Bell, AT&T, and Telcordia Technologies, Inc., in various management positions with responsibility for budgets and forecasting, financial analysis, marketing, legal/regulatory policy, and software systems development before retiring in 2011.

She has a B.A. in Psychology from Rutgers University and an Executive MBA from Pace University. She and her husband, Jon Howard, have two grown daughters.
